Sub: Registration of complaint as F.I.R.

Sir,
I, Tapan Kumar Khatua s/o late Makhanlal Khatua of Village gangra, P.O. Sonachura aged about 32 years do hereby lodge complaint with you on the facts as follows:-

On 10.11.2007, my elder brother Tapas Khatua and myself joined in a procession from Sonachura in the morning hours under banners of Bhumi Uchhed Protirodh Committee (B.U.P.C.), while we reached at Kamarpara more at about 12 noon. The procession faced attack from miscreants elements armed with modern automatic guns. The attackers were carrying the red flags of CPIM. They were wearing black robes. They attacked the procession from two points i.e. front and back, at the same time. We know the attackers are party cadres and hired goons of CPIM. Due to sudden and indiscriminate firings, the people started fleeing and my brother, Tapas Khatua received bullet injury on his waist from back. He felled down on the ground. Under firing I noticed him collapsing and could take the risk to save my brother's life with the help of others. Critically injured my brother was brought to Nandigram P.H.C., from there to Tamluk Hospital and ultimately to S.S.K.M. hospital, Kolkata. My brother is fighting with life due to fire of bullets by those CPIM miscreants.

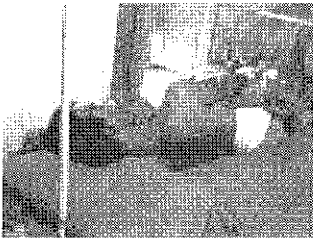
I have witnessed as member of procession number of persons were killed, injured for such attack. The attackers indulged in to widespread looting and arson. I also heard number of women were gang raped on the date of incident by those miscreants.

You are requested to register my complaint and initiate criminal proceeding against the attackers of CPIM immediately and punish them in accordance with law.

I want to specify that Mr. Lakhsman Seth, M.P. , Mr. Asoke Guria, Mr. Himangshu Das, Mr. Joydev Pyke, Mr. Arup Mondal and Mr. Badal Mondal are real conspirators and organizers of the said attack.
