Sir,

With due respect, I, Sri Sankar Pramanik s/o late Bhagaban Pramanik of village & P.O. Gokulnagar, Nandigram, P.S. Nandigram, district: East Midnapur lodge this complaint with you and narrate this fact as follows:-

My brother, Sanat Pramanik and myself, who reside together in joint mess, joined in a procession organized by B.U.P.C. The huge procession originated from Sonachura on 10.11.2007 at about 9/9-30 a.m. We started walking in the procession at about 10a.m. from Gokulnagar. We walked towards Maheshpur and Tekhali bazaar along with the Pradhan mantra Sarak Jojna Road, at about 12/ 12-30 p.m. at Kamarpukur more as known popularly on the main pucca road, a frontal part of the procession faced bullet spray from front and from the back. The number of assailants was nearly 200. They were armed with sophisticated arms. While this procession was proceeding towards Tekhali, the firing was started from the hidden places. I know these persons were mainly cadres of C.P.I.(M) and hired killers. They were wearing black robes. They fired discriminately targeting the persons in the procession. Due to firing of bullets, my brother got bullet injury in his left knee. After he felled down in the nearby field, the attackers hit on hip with butt of automatic rifle. My brother, Sanat Pramanik attempted to run while the fire started but due to injury he could not move more. Under the spray of bullets we had to disburse for protection, I waited for about two hours to reach to him. My brother could drag himself some distance. I helped my brother to carry him to Nandigram Primary Health Center. From there he was referred to Tamruk Hospital. As the condition of my brother became critical he was referred to S.S.K.M. hospital, Kolkata. At midnight I reached S.S.K.M. with my brother on the midnight of 10-11 November 2007. My brother is fighting with death.

I have witnessed the human killings by the attackers with sophisticated arms. I think there were fifty persons who died due to bullet injury and the miscreants of C.P.I.(M) are liable for mass killing. The number is injured is enormous. Many bodies were carried away to some other places by those attackers of C.P.I.(M). Two rape victims traveled with me from Tomruk to Kolkata. There were arson and loot.

I lodged complaint with you to initiate to criminal proceeding against all these persons responsible for mass killing.
